

Conditions of Issue

1. This licence may only be used to move cattle (bovine animals) that are included in a TB Control plan for common grazing in England. Any movement of cattle under this licence must comply with the criteria included in the attached TB Control Plan to be exempt from the need for Pre-Movement testing before the cattle return to the grazier member's premises (that must be named in the association's TB Control Plan).
 2. During movement off the common grazing land cattle moving under this licence must not be allowed to come into contact with any other cattle of a different health status.
 3. This licence is issued to the commoners association or council or the owner of the TB Control Plan. The Keeper of the cattle being moved is responsible for compliance with the conditions of the licence and this licence may be amended, suspended or revoked, in writing, at any time.
 4. The keeper shall, on demand by a Veterinary Inspector, an Officer of the Department or by an Inspector of the Local Authority or by a member of a police force, furnish his/her name and address and shall produce a copy of this licence and allow it to be copied.
 5. This licence may not be used to move animals from premises subject to restrictions for any other animal disease.
 6. This licence cannot be used to move cattle off a premises subject to TB restrictions.
 7. This licence may be used for moves from the common grazing land detailed overleaf provided the moves are recorded.
